Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 9 nays on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: The Maresh amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, do you have another amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Senator Newell moves to amend the proposed rule change. (Read the Newell amendment.)

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President and members of the body, because of the time constraints and because of the fact I don't think I have the votes on this, I'm going to withdraw it.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Simon, do you wish to speak to this?

SENATOR SIMON: Are we on the merits, lack of merits to the amendment now?

SENATOR NICHOL: The amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, do you have another amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Senator Lamb moves to amend, Mr. President. (Read the Lamb amendment.)

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. Chairman, that was for the Committee amendment to the Carsten rule change and so it's not appropriate at this point so I would withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: Are there any objections? It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch moves to amend proposed rule change number 4. (Read the Koch amendment as found on Page 2310 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Koch.
