SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed no. The motion is to cease debate. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Senator Lewis, have you closed on your amendment? Okay, the vote is on the Lewis amendment as explained. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried. We have one more, and the amendment is adopted. Have you got one more amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp moves to refer the proposed rule change back to the Rules Committee for further consideration.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well, there have been so many on it, I just don't know where we are any more, and I just think maybe the Rules Committee between now and next January when we all get together again ought to get a second look, and I just think it makes sense.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. The motion is cease debate. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Shall debate cease? Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp, have you finished? Okay, the motion is the adoption of the DeCamp motion. Senator Beutler. No, Senator DeCamp has closed. Okay, read the motion.

CLERK: The motion is to refer this proposed rule change back to the Rules Committee.
