What has to be included in the committee statement and we had set out in the subsections of this subsection (a) the requirements those, itemization of those items that should be included in the committee statement. Item 2 is the roll call vote of final committee action taken on a bill "and on any amendments thereto", that is the phrase that we are dropping, "and on any amendments thereto". Senator Reutzel pointed out, rightfully I think, that showing a roll call vote on each and every amendment may be in a number of instances an obnoxious requirement and really serves no valid purpose. So, I am in full agreement with deleting words and on any amendment thereto.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, if I would be certainly in agreement with Senator Beutler and Senator Reutzel on the innocuous amendments but sometimes many of these amendments are quite significant and can change the whole concept of the initial piece of legislation. If a roll call vote is necessary and prudent on the bill, I think if an amendment is so serious, so substantive that it changes the content and the subject matter that ought to be a matter of public record also. I think I would be uncomfortable about eliminating the requirement of roll call vote for amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any other discussion? Senator Beutler do you have any close? The motion is on the Beutler amendment to Section 17-A(2). All those in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Okay, the Clerk will record the vote.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Could we have a Call of the House and a record vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, before we take this up the members of the Executive Board are asked to assemble in room 2102 to begin to reference bills. Call of the House has been requested do I see five hands? Question is shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.
