CLERK: No one is excused Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Merz, Senator Haberman, Senator Barrett, Senator Lewis, Senator Chambers, Senator Kelly, Senator Venditte, Senator Labedz, Senator Clark. Mr. Sergeant at Arms, will you please gather together your brigade and begin calls to bring legislators back so that we can proceed with the business. Mr. Sergeant at Arms, I will read the list once more and you need to get your group together and bring in those that are not...that have not recorded. Senator Warner, Senator Schmit, Senator Lamb, Senator Merz, Senator Lewis, Senator Kelly, Senator Labedz and Senator Clark. Okay, the Clerk can take in call ins.

CLERK: Senator Kelly voting aye, Senator Carsten voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: For those who have just come in the motion is the adoption of the Beutler amendment found on page 19 which would indicate that a roll call vote is not necessary when there are committee amendments, as I understand the motion.

CLERK: Senator Lewis voting aye, Senator Keyes voting aye, Senator Pirsch changing from no to yes, Senator Kahle had voted yes, Senator Kahle changing from yes to no. Senator Lamb voting no, Senator Warner voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Senator Beutler do you want to proceed with the roll call vote? I don't like to hurry up business but we do need to get to some other business. Okay, the Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 13 nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, motion carried the amendment is adopted. Senator Fowler, do you wish to make a motion on the whole package now? We have completed the amendments. I will alert you once again to the fact that as soon as we get through with this item we will go to General File.

SENATOR FOWLER: I move the Call be raised.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Call is raised.

SENATOR FOWLER: I move that we adopt the permanent rules of the Legislature as amended, the understanding with the DeCamp amendment that none of the committee changes would take effect this session. They would then take effect at the end of the session. The Clerk has a question?
