CLERK: Senator do we not have to adopt the proposed Revamp of Rule Three and then adopt from that Rule?

SENATOR FOWLER: Certainly I will do that. I move that we adopt the proposed Revamp of Rule Three as amended first. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Carsten. Okay, you have heard the motion. Is there any further discussion? The motion is the adoption of Rule Three as Revamped, is that right?

CLERK: Yes sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Includes an amendment to...that will postpone the effect for a year. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays on the adoption of the proposed Revamp Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carries. Now Senator Fowler, do you have another motion?

SENATOR FOWLER: Now I move we adopt permanent rules as amended with the amendments from the Rules Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, you heard Senator Fowler's motion. Senator Carsten, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. It would appear to me and I would suggest that inasmuch as these rules are going to become a permanent guide for us to operate under, that this body as near as it can have a perfect attendance on this vote should be here. Then those of us that are absent for any reason, whenever that might be, can not say with any sound argument that we were not there and did not have an opportunity to vote. We will not have anything to back up against to fight our rules regardless whether they are adopted or not. I would ask Mr. Chairman, Mr. President, that we have a Call of the House for a vote on these rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, a Call of the House has been requested. Do I see five seconds? All those...okay, Senator Murphy do you wish to talk on the motion to place the House under Call? Senator Chambers do you wish to speak to the motion to place the House under Call? Okay, the motion is shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record the vote.
