SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair would ask Senator Warner would you please indicate your presence. Senator Chambers do you wish to be recognized on the motion to adopt the rules.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, all I can say at this point is from what I have heard on the discussion and the review I made of some of the rules the amendments offered, they seem, oh I'm speaking for the record, if anybody wants to listen it is all right with me.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I gaveled for order. Go ahead Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm not certain that I am in a position to vote to adopt the entire package now. Sometimes if I read everything that has been adopted as a totality I get a little different picture as to what has been done entirely, so, Senator Fowler, may I ask you a question? Mr. Chairman, is it all right with you? You want to go ahead and vote on this today, right? I'm sure that you can get it without my vote.

SENATOR FOWLER: The amendments that we adopted yesterday would take effect immediately. The ones that we discussed today with regards to the rule changes would not take effect till the end of this session. I think if they are adopted they can be printed. You would have the opportunity to give it the thorough reading that I know that you will, and that you can....

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You made the point, thank you Senator Fowler I will vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol and then Senator Kelly.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Fowler, which rules go into effect immediately and which ones go into effect next year, will you repeat that once more please.

SENATOR FOWLER: I misspoke. Not every rule we adopted yesterday will go into effect immediately. There is one for a one week recess that is delayed a year, and I apologize for that misstatement, Senator Goodrich pointed out my error to me. The others take effect immediately, that one takes effect next session.

SENATOR NICHOL: The rules governing committees....

SENATOR FOWLER:committees take effect, I believe the motion was at the end of this session, for the interim.
