LB 399

Schmit, you have amendments to LB 399. Do you wish to discuss them? Do you want to move the adoption of your amendments?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, the amendment strikes the specific language which says two times in any twelve month period and just says in plain language that in the event that anyone is found guilty of violation of this act they may be called before the Director of Agriculture, period. That is all the amendment does and I move adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CLARK PRESIDING

SENATOR CLARK: Now we are on the Schmit amendment to LB 399. Is there anyone who wants to talk on that? If not, the question is the adoption of the Schmit amendment to 399. All those in favor...do you want to vote on it now?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes.

SENATOR CLARK: All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Voting aye, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: Do you have any other amendments?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Senator Kahle now moves to indefinitely postpone LB 399.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Kahle.

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Presiding Officer, members of the body, I think after the discussion I will make this pretty short. I cannot see where this is going to help one bit the American farmer or the Nebraska meat producer. The bill has been changed completely from what we heard in committee.
