

Now I can't support this bill or any other bill with this kind of a provision in it. I can't put anybody outside of their duly constituted responsibility. Now I don't see how anybody in good conscience can vote for this with this section in there. I wouldn't even ask for this for an insurance agent and I is one. I wouldn't have the conscience to ask for this kind of a provision and I don't see how anybody can vote for that with this. I strongly urge you to support this amendment. I urge you, Senator Venditte and Senator Labeledz, to support this amendment because I think without it you have nothing. You have an unconstitutional piece of mess, that is what you have if you keep this kind of provision in there.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, let me add that Senator Dworak has made a very interesting inquiry here this afternoon but I would like to address in addition to his comments part of this particular piece of legislation that will cover the concerns that Senator Dworak has spoken of to you here this afternoon, and if you will please follow along with me, and, ladies and gentlemen, I am now in Section 7, subsection (2), Section 7, subsection (2), and what it says, Senator Dworak, is this. "However, nothing in this act shall deny the right of the Department to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse", Senator Dworak, "the renewal of or take disciplinary action against the license of any medical practitioner in accordance with Section 71-147." We have all the tools within our jurisdiction to take whatever disciplinary action is necessary against any physician who doesn't follow procedure, proper sound medical procedure, in treating a patient today who is suffering from cancer. So, Senator Dworak, I certainly am not suggesting that you cannot read but I don't think you read far enough in the bill and that, ladies and gentlemen, I think answers the serious concern that Senator Dworak had here this afternoon. Section 7, subsection (2) of that particular section covers the concern that Senator Dworak had.
