

system to say who, what, why, where and how when you, your wife, your neighbor, somebody ends up dead. It is not going to cost you a penny, it is going to save money. Maybe those savings are indirect on a county level, in the courts and all the other places but they are there. They do more important than that, or just as important, they tell the county attorney this is the system, they tell the sheriff this is the system and you have no excuses any more to duck it. I submit to you this will not cost, it will pay.

PRESIDENT: The question before the House is the adoption of the amendment, the DeCamp amendment to LB 222. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 5 nays on the adoption of Senator DeCamp's motion.

PRESIDENT: Motion carried. The amendments are adopted. Senator DeCamp, do you wish to now.....now we have some amendments on the desk. We will take them up in the order in which you have them on your desk, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a series of amendments offered by Senator Murphy. The first is to amend LB 222 (read amendment).

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: The amendments on the desk referred to the original bill and the misnomers such as references to district attorneys rather than county attorneys, things we don't have in this state and with the adoption of the new bill those amendments are not germane as we would say in the Attorney General's office and I withdraw them.

PRESIDENT: The amendments are withdrawn. There are some more amendments by Senator Murphy?

CLERK: Senator Murphy, I assume you want to withdraw all of yours, is that correct, sir?

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy, is that all of your amendments that you had up on the desk?

SENATOR MURPHY: I would not only like to withdraw the amendments, I'd like to withdraw the bill, but I can't do that, it is not my bill.

PRESIDENT: The amendments are withdrawn though.
