

withhold information from those who should know about the probate, Senator Kahle, and if it were possible to pick three newspapers and say, run twenty notices in each newspaper you would have a little more coverage than you do by just picking one, because as I stated a moment ago, Senator Kahle, the same newspaper goes to the same people and it so often does not reach the people that are intended to get it. So, as Senator Landis pointed out, we have another method of letting people know about real estate being probated and that is by direct mail and many times attorneys, I understand, use the telephone which are not required to but it is quicker, more expeditious and the Bar Association is desirous of getting these probates done and not to string them out any longer than they have to. So with that I suggest that it is a good bill. I think the Bar Association has done a good job on it, and I urge for the passage of LB 498.
