Is that any relation to Santa Claus, or what are we doing for the 17, 18, 19 year olds that is going to come about by this clause, this grandfather clause, and whose grandfather and what are we doing in it?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Well, what the grandfather clause does, Senator Keyes, is it provides that no drinking rights...no drinking privileges I should say are going to be taken away from any people that currently have them.

SENATOR KEYES: In other words, I might ask you then, a 19 year old today can go into the bar and drink and can drink in the park or in the baseball...on the baseball diamond, he will be able to keep drinking in the park and on the baseball diamond?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Well, it means that anybody who has turned 19 prior to the effective date of this act will have all the privileges that 19 year olds have had over the last ten years when the drinking age has been 19.

SENATOR KEYES: So that will mean that when you are 19 and 20 you can not only go in the bars and drink but you can walk away from your 19 and 20 year old friends and you can walk out to the park or you can buy a six-pack and take along with you.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Well, it will mean that anybody who is 19 prior to the effective date of this act will fall under the
