

SENATOR DWORAK: It seems like we are getting ourselves in another jam here, trying to put this together on the floor as we were accused of doing when we put one amendment on, and now we seem to be compounding that problem. A lot of things have happened now this morning that I have some real serious reservations about. I am not sure what kind of shape this bill is in. Mr. Speaker, is it possible to have this bill reprinted in the form it is in before we take corrective action until we are absolutely sure of what shape it is in? Do you think that might be advisable, Mr. Speaker...before we tack things on and glean things off, so we know exactly what form it is in?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Dworak, I think what we need to do to thoroughly clarify this is to address ourselves to all the amendments as soon as they are taken care of one way or the other, then we can print it and the Legislature can take a look at it.

SENATOR DWORAK: Most of the amendments this morning have been substantive amendments that do specific things. As I understand this amendment, it is just an attempt to correct and Senator DeCamp admitted that he is not so sure what is in and what is not out, and I am wondering if this type of amendment shouldn't be held back because it is nothing but...and he is trying to correct, is what he said he is trying to do, but he is not sure.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp, do you want to respond to the question?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Senator DeCamp is absolutely sure. He explained it. This makes certain that Hoagland-Dworak is struck. That is what we voted on before. We are merely reaffirming it to clarify it...not a difficult concept to understand. This adds the grandfather clause, not that difficult a concept to understand either. I don't know how much explanation is necessary, Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Then the first amendment did not strike the Hoagland-Dworak amendment. That is, in fact, what we are doing now?

SENATOR DeCAMP: We are making sure the Hoagland-Dworak amendment is completely struck.

SENATOR DWORAK: Thank you.
