SENATOR KELLY: Respectfully, Mr. Speaker, I call the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay, I see five hands. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed no. The question is, shall debate cease? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Debate ceases. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I waive closing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the DeCamp-Reutzell amendment as discussed vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the last amendment as discussed. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 4 nays on adoption of the DeCamp amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Is there further business on the bill?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, Senator Koch now moves to indefinitely postpone LB 221. Pursuant to our rules that would lay the bill over.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch, do you wish to take up the amendment? You have an amendment up here. It will lay the bill over until tomorrow. Okay. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, we recognize that a kill motion at this stage in the game, when by the same introducer this motion on General File, that motion lost... I can't just quite remember but I think there was something pretty close to 30 votes against a kill motion at that time. I recognize this kill motion for what it is, but, Mr. Speaker, I plead with you that the lay-over move for a kill motion is in the interest of the introducer to prepare his remarks to defend his bill. I feel no need for a lay-over whatsoever and respectfully request the Speaker to take that vote now.
