LB 235

PRESIDENT: We will proceed then with the next bill on Select File, LB 235.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have E & R amendments to LB 235.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stoney, would you take care of the E & R amendments? Senator Wesely is not here.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 235.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 235. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by voting aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments on LB 235 are adopted. Any amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nichol now moves to amend and his amendment is found on page 426 and 427 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, this should have been in there to start with but it wasn't due to I suppose an attorney's omission. I hate to pick on them any more but it should have been in and if you will note on the amendment, line 4, cross out "this" and you put in "Other than for the purposes of validating a conveyance, this section shall not excuse compliance with all applicable zoning and subdivision ordinances." So all it does is make it more clear that the only reason is for validating conveyances. I move for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion on the Nichol amendment? If not, Senator Nichol, I guess that will be your opening and your closing. The motion is the adoption of the Nichol amendment to LB 235. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? If everybody would vote quickly enough, we could move some of these bills on Select File I think. I am sure the Speaker would like to get something done yet this morning. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Nichol's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Any further amendments?
