SENATOR CHAMBERS: Those who do not learn from the mistakes of history are doomed to repeat them. I have nothing to lose. I say, shoot the works. Let there come a war in the Persian Gulf, but remember this, there are people with long bitter memories about what has happened in this country and my eyes won't have to look thousands of miles to the Persian Gulf to find those who have tried to deny me of my freedom and degrade my children.
