

Thank you. I want the people of this state to know that we have certain senators that will deny the right of the senators on the floor of this Legislature to talk on these bills.

PRESIDENT: Just...without debating it, the Chair is just going to state we debated this whole matter for over two hours. I think the Speaker will confirm that and the debate was on the motion until late yesterday when we got to the kill motion and that was also debating the issue. So we will proceed then. Senator Haberman, I guess it is up to you to close on your motion at this time.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Let's just go ahead and vote, Mr. President, and save some time.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Haberman doesn't... The motion then is, shall LR 30 be advanced to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye... did you wish...? Machine vote, all right, let's go to the board. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: ...record vote.

PRESIDENT: All right, a record vote is requested. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 484 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and LR 30 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. We will proceed then on Select File with LB 598, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are no E & R amendments to LB 598. However, I have two amendments. The first is offered by Senator Maresh.

PRESIDENT: All right, the Chair recognizes Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, what my amendment does it changes from one issuance of the session laws and the legislative journals to two. Presently we get only one copy of each, the bound copies and if you have one at home then you don't have any here. If you leave it here you don't have one at home, so I think we should change the law to issue two copies of each of these publications. I move that this amendment be adopted.
