SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Merz.

SENATOR MERZ: Mr. President and members of the body, this is a minor bill and all it does is in relocating roads of a minor proportion the county officials can go ahead and do this without having to put out notice in the paper and have hearings that run into a lot of expense. So I had no opposition in committee hearing, so I would ask your support in moving this bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 607 to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted...we are voting on the advancement of 607 to E & R for Review. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill, 599.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 599 was introduced by Senator Jerome Warner of the 25th. (Read title to LB 599.) The bill was read on January 9 of this year. It was referred to the Revenue Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President, by Senator Carsten's Revenue Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner. Oh, Senator Carsten, do you wish to adopt the committee amendments?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move for the adoption of the committee amendments. The committee amendments were brought to us by Senator Warner and this is a clean-up bill to 187 of last year. It deals with the motor vehicle taxes for the year '81 that shall be taxed on assessed valuation of a percentage of the actual value for that year. The purpose is for the transition from the use of assessed value to actual value, since motor vehicles are based on the prior year's levy.
