

a higher level as opposed to a lower level so that it would be in compliance with their ability to derive revenue. I move for the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 599. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. The sheets that are being circulated at the moment are those that give a one-line explanation to the bills that we will take up as soon as we are through with 658 on General File. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendments are adopted. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 599 be advanced. As Senator Carsten has indicated the bill merely is a clean-up bill for 187 last session. The first six sections make adjustments where there were two more decimal points in calculating the cents per hundred dollars of actual value and it was the intent that it should only be one decimal point. From the seventh section on to the end of the bill it merely reflects legislation that was enacted last session, bills that were enacted that dealt with mills and the bill drafter in the processing of that legislation left it in mills until the legislation was enacted, and this correlates all that. It makes no other change. The operative date corresponds with the operative date of LB 187. So I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 599 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the advancement of 599 to E & R for Review. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Next, 658.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 658 was introduced by Senator Chris Beutler. (Read title to LB 658.) The bill was read for the first time on January 10 of this year. It was referred to the Revenue Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Carsten's Revenue Committee.
