SENATOR MARESH: I so move.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of advancing LB 44 to E & R for engrossment vote aye, opposed no. Okay. Say aye, opposed no. A machine vote requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Advancement of the bill. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Are we ready for LB 641.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Cullan moves to add the emergency clause to LB 641.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, just to remind the body this is the bill which reestablishes the Rural Health Manpower Commission and changes its association and straightens out its association with the Department of Health. The emergency clause is simply requested so that it can become effective on adjournment or whatever. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Cullan amendment to 641. All those in favor, the amendment is the emergency clause, add the emergency clause. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 641 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill to E & R for engrossment say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. Next number, 698.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are no E & R amendments to 698.
