SENATOR KREMER: Actual expense.

SENATOR MURPHY: ...travel and that. Do you know what the Commission spent totally in expenses and per diem last year?

SENATOR KREMER: I have a record of what each one of the Commissioners received in the way of reimbursement here if you would like to have it, Senator. I do not....yes, I do have the total. The total for last year was...for 1978 it was \$7,510; for 1979 it was \$7,430.

SENATOR MURPHY: That is travel and per diem?

SENATOR KREMER: This is per diem paid to the Commissioners. This is per diem. No sir, this is not travel.

SENATOR MURPHY: Well, I was looking for the (interruption) of travel expenses.

SENATOR KREMER: This is not travel...this is not travel, sir. I believe in travel they are allowed the same mileage that we are.

SENATOR MURPHY: I was just curious what our total expense was getting to be for this Commission. Possibly we can visit further about it. Thank you.
