LB 816

LB 816 was introduced by the Public Health and Welfare Committee and signed by the members thereof. (Read title to LB 816.) The bill was read on January 17. It was referred to the Public Health Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Cullan's Public Health Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kennedy, are you going to take the amendments?

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes, the amendment is a technical amendment. This bill was brought to us by Rex Higley of the Bureau of Examining Boards and the bill and the amendment was to correspond so that the State of Nebraska would be compatible with those of the United States on a nuclear regulative commission's regulations and we have a little problem that we are not in compliance and so this bill and the amendment would correct those appliance, so that we would be adopting the current federal regulations. I think it is a real simple bill. As far as the amendment, it is just a correction because of the wording in the original bill. The bill was brought to us by Rex Higley out of the Health Department and I think it is a very important bill because of the treatment in hospitals for radiation handling that the doctors must have this to be in compliance. I would move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt the committee amendments to LB 816. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Kennedy, what will you do with the bill?

SENATOR KENNEDY: I would now ask for LB 816 as amended to be advanced at this time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any further discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.
