CLERK: Senator Hoagland changing from no to yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Chambers.

CLERK: Senator Venditte voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Labeledz, Senator Reutzel. Will you please record your presence?

CLERK: Senator Reutzel voting aye. Senator Beutler voting aye. Senator Sieck voting aye.
