LB 635, 703

amendments to LB 635. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the adoption of the committee amendments to 635. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The committee amendments to 635 are adopted. Senator Rumery.

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move the advancement of LB 635 as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have any further explanation?

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President, this bill simply excludes the county attorney or assistant county attorney from the presence of a grand jury when a special prosecutor has been appointed, because of the apparent necessity of investigating the official acts of county officials. We think that this just cleans up the bill...the law as it now is and makes it more workable, and you will notice that no one appeared in opposition to the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the advancement of the bill vote aye, opposed no. The motion is to advance 635 to E & R for Review. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. For your records, we are passing over LB 986 and taking up LB 703, and there are committee...

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 703 was introduced by Senator Glenn Goodrich. (Read title to LB 703.) The bill was read on January 10, referred to the Urban Affairs Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I have committee amendments by Senator George's Urban Affairs Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, the amendments were suggested by Dr. Soshnik, the financial advisor for the city of Omaha. It would simply allow in addition to a public sale also a private sale of these revenue bonds for parking facilities. In addition to that we are striking
