SPEAKER MARVEL: LB 914.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, the amendments to LB 914 delays the transfer of this property. This property is located in Senator Powers' District. Mr. Speaker, can we have a little quiet so I can hear myself? Mr. Speaker, the amendments to LB 914 delays the transfer of this property in Omaha to June 30th, 1981. This property is located in Senator Powers' District and the committee was told by Senator Powers that the building is presently occupied by the childrens' museum and the people there would like to delay the transfer, so the committee agreed to delayed this until June 30, 1981. I move that the amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 914. Senator Dworak, your light is on. Do you wish to.....Senator Murphy, your light is on. Okay, the motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to 914. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The committee amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 914 be advanced to E & R Initial. This is some property that the Department of Labor presently owns and they wish to transfer it and this was called to our attention by the Labor Commissioner. I thought probably this could be done by a resolution. We asked for an opinion from the Attorney General. He said, no, we have to have a bill to transfer this property. So we introduced the bill and I move that the bill be advanced.
