

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, a Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor of the House going under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats, record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Powers, Senator Koch, Senator Cope, Senator Keyes, Senator Schmit, Senator Beutler, Senator Lamb, Senator Merz, Senator Goodrich, Senator Wagner, Senator Lewis, Senator Carsten, no he is already here. Is Merz excused? The Clerk is authorized to take call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting aye. Senator Barrett voting aye. Senator Cope had voted aye, Senator. Senator Chronister voting aye. Senator Merz voting aye. Senator Reutzel voting no....still voting no. Senator Vickers voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, once more, Senator Powers, Senator Keyes, Senator Schmit, Senator Lamb, Senator Goodrich, Senator Frank Lewis. Have you all voted?

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, who is excused?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator, there are one, two, three, four, five, six excused. No, Senator, five. There are four absent, Senator Clark, Senator Pirsch, Senator Cullan and Senator Haberman. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: I would like a roll call vote.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I want everyone here that isn't here unexcused.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Mr. Sergeant at Arms, Ray. Senator Powers..have you got a pencil and paper there? Senator Powers, Senator Keyes, Senator Schmit, Senator Lamb, Senator Goodrich. Senator....time actually has expired but we are in the middle of the vote and we have to take the vote first before we can conclude this. Okay, all we have...will you see if you can find...Senator Koch, we are down to Senator Goodrich. All right, proceed with the roll call vote.

CLERK: (Roll call vote was read as found on page 613 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President. 22 ayes, 18 nays.
