debt in the first place. So what good are defenses? How do they know what was or wasn't done? LB 306 is not necessary. It goes way beyond what anybody thinks it does, in my humble opinion. I believe Senator Beutler would be well-advised to withdraw the bill which I am sure he won't. I would agree as Chairman of the Banking Committee that if he wants to have an interim study on the particular issue involved, we would be happy to do it and see if there is some system that will work that doesn't do what this does.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Your time is up. The motion before the House is the adoption...the Beutler amendment. All those in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Beutler amendment to LB 306. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Beutler amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Do you want to move the advancement of the bill? Okay, all those in favor of advancing... Machine vote requested?

SENATOR MARSH: I have an opportunity to speak on the bill as amended, I understand, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, Senator Beutler was closing on his amendment.

SENATOR MARSH: But the amendment was adopted, therefore, we have an amended bill which now has to be moved to the advance...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion before the House is the advancement of the bill. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you very much, Mr. Speaker. I am standing to alert the legislative body again. I hope you were listening when Senator John DeCamp was speaking. This bill is not needed. This bill creates some serious legal problems. Have you talked to your banker? Have you talked to your accountant? Have you talked to your spouse? Let's not advance 306 to have to have it read on Final Reading. Let's leave it where it is now.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we have Senator Hoagland, Senator Schmit, Senator Landis, Senator Beutler, Senator DeCamp. Enough said. Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. Speaker, I would just like to make a
