SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. Senator Kennedy, Senator Landis, Senator Cope, Senator Keyes, Senator Fowler, Senator Rumery, Senator Lamb, Senator Newell, Senator Simon, Senator Nichol, Senator Labedz. There are six absent. Senator Keyes, just record your presence. Senator Kahle, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I already explained it just doesn't go as far as Senator Kahle did. I guess I thought the salary thing was a big thing. The Governor has some reservations about some of the other parts. I think this is reasonable on both sides. It says the salary guidelines set out in sections 1 through 6 are designed to be advisory and to recognize the importance of the office of county sheriff.
