SENATOR STONEY: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the amendment to 228 vote aye, opposed vote no. These are, in effect, Senator Fowler, the Steinmiller amendments, right?

SENATOR FOWLER: Essentially, yes, right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record the vote.

SENATOR FOWLER: I have no pride of authorship, if that is what you mean.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Fowler amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Fowler. The motion is the advancement of 228 to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Senator Wesely, there are E & R amendments to LB 228A.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move those E & R amendments to LB 228A.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted. Ready to advance the bill?

SENATOR WESELY: I move it be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. LB 228 is advanced. Do you have anything to read in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Quickly, Mr. President. Your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and engrossed LB 863 and find the same correctly engrossed.
