assets that no longer can be disgorged and what have you. The final question is, would this be contrary to the purposes of the act. Well the purposes of the act are to tide unemployed workers over between jobs. That is the real purpose. If it is, then the claimant won't have to repay. That is all there is to it. This is not an amendment that is designed to promote fraud, cheating, dishonesty or even fudging on the truth. It just says in some circumstances somebody really ought not to have to repay monies that they received and we ought to leave this in the discretion of the commissioner in determining when those circumstances arise. I would again support my amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is on the adoption of the Johnson amendment to the committee amendment to 798. All in favor of the Johnson amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Johnson amendment to the committee amendment. The Chair is not going to call for another vote. Have you all voted? Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 13 nays on the adoption of the Johnson amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion failed. Senator Maresh, do you want to move the adoption of the committee amendment?

SENATOR MARESH: Now we have a good amendment so I move that the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendment to LB 798. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: I move that LB 798 be advanced to E & R initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of the bill to E & R for review. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.
