CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Reutzel moves to indefinitely postpone the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, I think first of all since we really didn't discuss the bill on General File I would like to have Senator Cullan explain the bill before we get further into the kill motion.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Reutzel. Senator Cullan, do you want to explain the bill?

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this bill was advanced from General File a few minutes before noon and we haven't had a great deal of time to talk about the bill. The bill was amended by the Judiciary Committee, and in its current form, the bill adds a district judge in the 16th Judicial District which includes five counties in the northwestern corner of the State of Nebraska, also in the 21st Judicial District which is a large judicial district in the Columbus area and the bill also adds a county judge in Hall County which is the Grand Island area.
