LB 843, 844

is the advancement of the bill as amended.

SENATOR VICKERS: Yes, I move the advancement of the bill as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is the advancement of 843 to E & R for review. While we are still on LB 843, underneath the North balcony, Ruth Mary Landis, the mother of Senator Landis. Will you please stand so we may greet you? Have you all voted? Have you all cast your...? Those of you who wish to vote, have you voted? Senator Vickers, we are getting down to the end. There are six bills after this bill but I am not sure we are going to survive that long. Have you all voted? Senator Vickers, what would you like to do?

SENATOR VICKERS: Well I hate to do it this late in the day but I think I am going to have to ask for a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you asking for a Call of the House? Shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The House is under Call. All legislators please record your presence. The Clerk is authorized to accept call in votes. Will you please record your presence? Will you please record your presence? Senator Goodrich, are you there? Senator Wagner, Senator Newell. If you will all record your presence I think we can proceed. We have six bills left. The Clerk is authorized to accept call in votes.

CLERK: Senator Maresh voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill as amended is advanced. The next bill is LB 844. The House is still under Call yet.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 844 was introduced by Senator Haberman. (Read title.) It was read on January 21, referred to Education, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kahle.
