CLERK: Five, Senator.

SENATOR KAHLE: Well, there is no use sitting here looking at that board. I ask for a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Call of the House? Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed no. The motion before the House is a Call of the House. Record.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. Senator Powers, Senator Kennedy, Senator Koch, Senator Wesely, Senator Rumery, Senator Beutler, Senator Kahle, Senator Sieck, Senator Kremer, Senator DeCamp, Senator Dworak, Senator Hoagland, Senator Simon, Senator Nichol, Senator Pirsch, Senator Clark. Senator Rumery. Okay, the Clerk is authorized to take call-in votes. Senator Rumery voted aye. Did you vote aye, Senator Rumery?

CLERK: Senator Rumery voting aye. Senator Schmit....Senator Reutzel voting aye. Senator Schmit, are you voting, sir? Senator Schmit voting aye. Senator Stoney voting no. Senator Kelly voting aye. Senator Goodrich voting no. Senator Barrett voting....you had voted aye, Senator.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy. Senator Murphy is voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Murphy voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Labeledz, we are looking for.

CLERK: Senator Wesely voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kremer, would you like to record your presence? Senator Labeledz. Ray, Senator Labeledz. The House is under Call. All legislators are to be in their seats. We cannot proceed until all legislators get in their seats.

CLERK: Senator Fowler voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We have one....Senator Labeledz is unaccounted for. Everybody else is accounted for. Do you want to ask for a roll call vote?
