SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I would just add a couple of comments to what Senator Johnson has said. This type of law, this type of amendment may be something you would want to consider some day but I would remind you that this has had no public hearing and this is a brand new subject matter and to give you an idea of some of the things that you might want to discuss at a public hearing on an amendment like this, let me just point out to you some of the problems with this particular amendment. First of all, the amendment isn't directed to lawyers only. It says, "any person who drafts or prepares a will shall not receive any property." Okay, we have in Nebraska a law that allows what are called holographic wills. You can sit down and write your own will. You can write a will for your wife. You and your wife can sit down together and write a will but you get into big problems doing that if this amendment passes because this would apply to a wife or to a husband or to our relatives who sit down together and draw up wills. It says "any person". Secondly, even if you construed it to apply only to lawyers and narrowed the broadness of the amendment, do you really want to apply to lawyers in every case? Hattie, my wife, and I can't sit down and draw up our wills together? I can't help her out? I can't help out my wife? My father? My relatives? They have been looking forward for a long time to getting some free help on those things. So there are a lot of questions on this amendment and if Senator Wesely is interested in it, it might be worth exploring but I think it really would need a good public hearing. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp. Senator DeCamp calls the question. Do I see five hands? No. The question before the House is shall debate cease. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.
