CLERK: Mr. President, I now have before us then the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I now renew my motion to approve the committee amendments as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments as amended. Does anyone else wish to speak to those? You are closing, Senator Carsten. Senator Carsten, you were closing on the committee amendments? Okay, the motion is the adoption of the committee amendments as amended to LB 361. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of the amended committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. Committee amendments as amended are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, yes, I have several amendments to the bill now. The first that I have is by Senator Maresch that were found on page 1179 but he wishes to withdraw. There were two sets and I think he wants to withdraw both.

Mr. President, I then have the Landis amendment previously discussed.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, this is coitus interruptus here on this issue but this apparently is the appropriate time to offer the amendment and I have apparently brought it now in a timely manner and the arguments and issues have already been laid out there. I don't intend to go on at great length. I will listen to some more of the speeches either in favor or against the amendment and then make a closing but I do offer the amendment previously explained at now, the timely moment in legislative consideration.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Landis amendment to LB 361. Senator Cullan.
