SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I would again like to emphasize the fact before this vote is taken on overruling the Chair, that a letter is being prepared to question whether or not this amendment would be constitutional or legally right to put on LB 741. I could also put on an amendment there to delete the word "obsolete" but that is going to take just that much more time and I assure you that I will do it and go back to eliminating the word obsolete and then your bill will read repeal laws. I urge each and everyone of you in the interest of time to go ahead and overrule the Chair which I apologize for, Mr. Speaker, because I don't like to do those things. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I think overruling the Chair would be a complete disaster in this case. The basis, says Senator DeCamp, is that this bill is a repealer bill, so it is. If you stop and think about it so are about three-quarters of our other bill. Almost every bill that we pass when we amend the statutes repeals the original statute, it is a repealer bill. If you open the door here and say that this is allowable in this case, then I submit to you that you can try to amend almost any bill that we pass on the basis that it is a repealer bill if what you are trying to get into the bill is to repeal some section of the statutes. This is opening the barn door wide open and I don't think that we should do this for any bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I would indicate that the rules do state that you speak once, that is it. The Chair will now recognize Senator Kelly and then Senator Newell.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, I call the question. I don't call the question. Yes, I do call the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. No, this is...the motion at the moment is shall the debate cease. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 12 nays to cease debate Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Senator Newell. Senator Kelly, you have used up your time. Senator Newell.
