

SENATOR SCHMIT: Okay, that is okay, I just wanted to know is there some concern on the part of the Natural Resources District? I understand that they are perhaps a little bit unhappy with this, they might like to dump it. If that happens, are we going to have to pick up more of that cost or what is going to happen?

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Schmit, I stand corrected a little bit. The money that I talked about with the NRD's and leasing, that is going to be in LB 1002, that is in the operating budget. This \$776,000 is all for acquiring and purchasing land, authorization for it.

SENATOR SCHMIT: What kind of a program is that? I mean where did it originate, whose idea was it, how extensive is it, where will the land be acquired?

SENATOR WARNER: Senator, maybe I should defer that part to Senator Dworak that reflects.....

SENATOR SCHMIT: I don't think that I want that much information, Mr. President. I would like to.....

SENATOR WARNER: Well it reflects the passage of legislation two or three years ago in which you will recall had the habitat stamp and a portion of those funds can be used and are used for the acquisition of property, they do not have the right of eminent domain though.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Okay, another question, where is Camp Newman, Senator Warner. It is on the bottom of 78 also. \$470,000.

SENATOR WARNER: Those are federal funds. They are west of Louisville, three, were three private parks very attractive areas and this particular piece of property was, is offered by the previous owners to the state and there will be a section of three properties that might eventually be acquired be a major park area but there are substantial facilities there including, and I don't recall if this one has the swimming pool or not but there are cabins, cooking facilities. Essentially it is a developed camp ready to go and the state can take it over with a minimum amount of capital investment in terms of improvement.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Okay, on page 79 I see we are going to develop some more camp grounds, day use areas, headquarter facilities other improvements at state recreation areas state wide, \$631,000. Can you give me briefly, very briefly because I have several other question an idea as to where that is going to be at, the top of page 79?
