brought up, whether it be delayed until later so that we do not take endless time to discuss it here when we are on Final Reading. Mr. Speaker, would you consider that, that you would then place it on the Agenda when you want to put it on the Agenda? In other words, we are not going to go right into the Select File stage if it is returned. This is going to be my ruling.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Would you mind repeating your question? I was answering another one.

PRESIDENT: Yes, my point is this, we are only debating the return of this bill for the purpose of the amendments. So the question of division is not before us until it is returned. At that time I am going to leave up to you, Mr. Speaker, the setting of that bill on Select File for its specific debate rather than to go right into it and continue this thing all morning.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I think the problem is that when you make a motion to return a bill there has to be some reason for that return and then the question is, how far do you go in debate before it is established what the reason is.

PRESIDENT: Right. That's right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: That's what we're....

PRESIDENT: What I'm saying is that we....I would like to have the body avoid repetition because we are going to get involved in this again then when we come back to the discussion on the Select File stage, so....which I know they are going to discuss again because they are going to ask for a division of the question. All right, we still have numerous people that wish to speak on this return. Try to address yourself to the return, although as Speaker Marvel says, it is all involved in the total package. Before we do that, I would like to introduce...before we get to the next speaker, I would like to introduce some eight students, seniors from Ralston High School from Senator Koch's District, with Larry Koenig. They are here in the north balcony. Would the Ralston High seniors and their teacher stand up. Welcome. And we also have from Senator Warner's District some nineteen seniors from Elmwood High School with teacher Mr. Jan Kuxhausen. They are also in the north balcony. Would they stand and be recognized. Welcome to Elmwood. Now the Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.
