SENATOR HOAGLAND: Well, let me explain it this way, Senator Marvel. Now, there are 25 different sections in this particular bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: And 19 or 20 of them are noncontroversial sections which are clarification and which are clearly going to make the act work better. Some of those changes are good and by good I mean it would be a real improvement to the act but we don't need to have them this year. Others may be necessary and others are necessary to get done this year, in my opinion. And of the 20...of the 19 or 20 sections that are noncontroversial improvements to the act to make it work better...I tried to put them in those three categories and I could be wrong about some of them, but essentially all 19 of those sections have been worked on very carefully for fourteen months through the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee by a lot of outside persons, by Commission staff, by a number of different individuals who are interested in coming in to improve the act, Senator Marvel, and what our motion is intended to do here is to take out those ones that are substantive changes, that are controversial and that are difficult, but leave in the housekeeping ones that are going to improve the act.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now which ones are the housekeeping ones?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: All the ones...all the 19 that are either necessary, possibly necessary or good. All the ones except the ones we are moving to take out. All right, we are moving to take out five sections completely and part of a sixth section, and those are the things that make the substantive changes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, can you give me the numbers of either the ones that you are taking out or the ones that you are leaving so I have....

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Sure.

SPEAKER MARVEL:got a record here of some kind?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Sure. Our motion that is up on the board now moves to strike sections 5, 14, 17, 19 and 24. Okay, have you got those? And it moves....

SEPAKER MARVEL: All right, 5, 14, 17, 19 and 24.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Just to take those sections out completely
