SPEAKER MARVEL: That Call was raised.

SENATOR FOWLER: Well, I would move....

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want a Call of the House?

SENATOR FOWLER: Yes, I would move for a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Burrows, Senator Landis, Senator Koch, Senator George, Senator Schmit, Senator Hefner...he's excused. Senator Merz, Senator DeCamp, Senator Lewis. The Clerk is authorized to take call-in votes. Senator Kelly. Mr. Sergeant at Arms, we are looking for Senator DeCamp.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Merz voting aye. Senator DeCamp voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The issue is the advancement of 222. Do you want to call the roll? Where is Senator Fowler? The motion before the House is the advancement of 222 to E & R for Engrossment. Ready for roll call vote?

SENATOR FOWLER: Are the four that are absent...are they excused?

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are actually five excused.

SENATOR FOWLER: That's pretty good.

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, there are four excused.

SENATOR FOWLER: Well, I guess if everybody is in their chair I would ask for a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All legislators please take your seats. We are under Call. Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on pages 1294 and 1295 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.
