SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record your presence. Have you all recorded your presence? Have you all recorded your presence? We can't begin until we get twenty-five ayes. CLERK: 912, Senator.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Second motion, LB 912.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. Speaker, I would move that LB 912 be advanced from Select File to E & R engrossing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Bill is advanced. Next bill, 696.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. Speaker, I would move that LB 696 be advanced from Select File to E & R engrossing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Are there E & R amendments? I was told there weren't. Okay, then we have to go back. What about the rest of them?

CLERK: Senator, there are E & R amendments we need to adopt on 696.
