LB 743

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I withdraw my motion, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You want to withdraw your motion. You want to strike your amendment?

SENATOR HABERMAN: I move to strike the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You can't do that. You have got to re-advance the bill first and then bring it back.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I move to advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Haberman made the motion to readvance the bill to E & R for engrossment. Do you want a machine vote? All those in favor of readvancing the bill to E & R for engrossment say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is readvanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, as I understand it, Senator Haberman would like to return LB 743 to Select File for a specific amendment, that amendment being to strike the Haberman amendment previously adopted on this day.

SENATOR HABERMAN: You stated it exactly correct, Pat.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All right, the motion is to readvance the bill....read the motion again.

CLERK: The first motion is to return the bill for a specific amendment, the amendment being to strike the Haberman amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All right, all those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We need a few more votes if we are going to get out of this dilemma. Does anybody else wish to vote? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 11 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the bill has been returned. Now the motion is to strike the bill, right?

CLERK: To strike the Haberman amendment previously adopted, yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, is that your motion, Senator Haberman? Okay, you have heard the motion. All in favor of striking
