

over the years that increased the spending and I'm willing to do it even this year, but I think that you have to recognize that if you can tell within \$80,000 of what the Plant Industry budget needs for western Nebraska, then you ought to take another look at what the ETV budget is. I want this to be a record vote, ladies and gentlemen, and I have some more amendments that will follow, but I do not intend to be shrugged off as a wayward child when I suggest that we can reduce this budget and this amount because when the time comes and the hard decisions need to be made as to whether or not people are going to be laid off or we buy a half a million dollars worth of equipment I'm not going to be known to be on the side of the equipment purchasers, and that is where you are at if you vote against this amendment. So I'm asking you, ladies and gentlemen, to support my amendment. It is reasonable, it is responsible, and it is the correct way to go.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to read the motion Pat, before we vote on it? All those in favor of the Schmit amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I ask for a roll call vote and a Call of the House. Let's have a Call of the House. Get everyone in here. When you are starting out nine in the hole from the budget committee, it is a pretty tough deal to get 25 for, but I'm willing to make a go at it.
