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right word that a technicality is involved because the Krugerrands went to the University Foundation but we know, we know that the ultimate recipient of the benefits will be the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. These Krugerrands were not earmarked for use of the income throughout the University system, Senator Warner. The income was specified for a definite purpose and it was on that campus. I was asked by at least one member, couldn't the resolution be adopted by the University, by the Legislature asking that the million dollars be given back. Such a resolution, even if it could pass the body, would not cause the University Foundation to do anything and personally I doubt that such a resolution would even get the votes required for passage by this Legislature. There come times in the life of all of us when we have to do those things that are required to be done by the circumstances and I just wish that there could be as many occasions when you all would have the opportunity to stand as one person against odds in the way that I have to do on so many occasions, then whether you would behave as I do or not, you would have a bit more understanding of the toll that is taken. The things you have to listen to day after day, how it is possible to condemn the source of the money but take the money anyway. You cannot separate the two, Senator Marsh. To take that which would benefit South Africa is to benefit South Africa and I know that there are people like Senator Fowler who will be in a very very difficult position and there are others who may not vote for this amendment, although I know the positions that you have taken on other matters. But here is what you have to understand about my situation. There are only rare opportunities when I am able to have an issue defined very clearly that will satisfy me as to the nature and character of the people that I am working with and dealing with. I, on occasion, saw Senator Duis stand right next to me and almost fall into tears because he was trying to get money for a small school in his area and out of consideration for Senator Duis they would give that money. I am not going to cry to you. I am not going to grovel before you. I am going to try to appeal to those sentiments that I am sure everybody has and that everybody would understand and tell you to situate yourself as I am often situated in this body, the things I am asked to vote for as a matter of principle and I hope you will accept this amendment and forget about breaking the budget and all of the other considerations because I am going to characterize this as what it is. It is a moral position. It is a symbol. It is a message to the University and the University Foundation. It is a message to the black
