

Congressman Bereuter, the point is that I was right. You don't like to be told that, I know. You are especially not going to like it a year or two or three from now when the conservation fund has enveloped and eclipsed the development fund. Because the lobbying is going to get intense on this end, on this thing. I know how we react to lobbyists, and you know how we react. Senator Dworak said that we talked about this twice already, we ought to let it alone. The budget acted. Had the budget committee acted in a more responsible manner we would not be standing here today arguing the issue. There are bills on that board that are of vital interest to all of us. There are bills that have been placed on special order. The Ag Committee has had some bills, the Retirement Committee has had some bills, there are people asking why can a bill be number one on general file for weeks and weeks and weeks and never move. That is going to be a question that some of us can answer to our constituents at a later date. The reason ladies and gentlemen is because the work in the committee does not justify that we leave it alone. It does not justify our acceptance. If you come into this court you should come with clean hands, Senator Dworak, you can't stand up and defend what is not right. I'm not saying that the budget in total is a mess of garbage. I know that you spend a lot of time on it and most of it I agree with, but, you make a farce of the entire process when you attempt to defend the indefensible. That is what you are doing. Oh, you can maybe shove it through, but it is wrong to do so. Senator Chambers spoke of being the minority. I know what it is like to be in the minority.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Your time is. . . .

SENATOR SCHMIT: It is not all bad.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Thirty seconds.

SENATOR SCHMIT: But not to know that you are in the wrong is worse. There is nothing wrong about being defeated. The thing that is bad is to know that you are wrong and not say so. Or to know that you are right and not comment on it. I think that you are going to have to face up and accept the consequences of this action unless you adopt Senator Kremer's proposal. I hope that you will support him on it.
