

would go ahead with the program yet this year but they will not fund this program after July of 1980. These two reservations that I am talking about are twenty-five miles from a county seat and as we all know criminal and civil jurisdiction for these two reservations are still under the state. When Santee, and this is in my legislative district, the 19th Legislative District, had their own program, their law enforcement program on this reservation their crime rate dropped 15%, a total of 15% drop in their crime rate after this program was started. I guess some of you would ask why and this was because they concentrated on prevention and this certainly helped their crime rate. Without this additional funding counties will have to furnish law enforcement for these reservations and the counties just do not have enough money. Considering the high cost of court appointed attorneys, incarceration and welfare for the families of the inmates, the state might actually save money by funding this program. This would be funding so that we could have a preventive law enforcement. All I am asking is that the state continue a program that was started by the federal government. This is police protection on these two Indian reservations. These LEAA funds were a three year starting program and now they have been discontinued. As I told you before, criminal jurisdiction on a reservation that is not retroceded is a responsibility of the state, therefore, I move for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Before we go on to a number of speakers that want to speak the Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel for a matter to be brought to your attention. Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I would like to refer to the agenda for a moment if I could.
