Johnson, a couple of others, we do have an amendment. We mentioned it to some of you that it has a direct rebate plan. It does involve a very direct system of property tax relief. We will offer this on Select File. It incorporates the Governor's and Senator Labedz's original concept and then goes to the additional rebate plan. The money that she is expending there and the money you gave the schools the other day would be about enough to fund this and it would not be any indirect or round robin relief. It would be a direct check to the homeowner and we hope you will give that favorable consideration. We will be getting you additional information between the time it moves now and Select File. We will offer it then.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay, the question is, shall debate cease? The question before the House is, shall debate cease? Have you all voted? We are voting on ceasing debate. Have you all voted? Record.

Debate is ceased. All those in favor of adoption of the committee amendments vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Well, I think we had better have an opportunity for everybody to participate, Mr. President. I move for a Call of the House and a record vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want a roll call vote? Shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.
