Commission that frequently ask for...every year ask for funds for some energy conservation method or procedures in review in their building. This suggests that they determine the feasibility of hooking up to the University's computerized energy management program. There is language affecting Nebraska Library Commission where there are some totally funded local programs with state general fund rather of local programs suggestion that there ought to be some cash fees charged for some of this program by those who participate reducing the load on the general fund. There is language suggesting that the Racing Commission should arrive at some more equitable basis for dates for the following racing season. The Department of Corrections has a number of recommendations, all of which reflect what the correctional improvement teams made in the way of recommendations in their report to the Legislature. Nebraska's Coordinating Commission on Postsecondary Education has language requesting a report on the utilization of various buildings as to...a type of utilization we are talking about here is where the space assignment for classes and so forth.. They are maximizing the available space. That will be helpful in analyzing requests for new buildings or for renovation of buildings that space is being used efficiently. Then there is language affecting the state colleges all of which, primarily all of which is boiler plate that calls for a series of reports that are requested. Every year the same is true of the University of Nebraska with a series of reports that are requested nearly every year. The State Historical Society is a request that they would submit a preliminary plan and outline estimated expenses for constructing displays at the new Heritage Center for next year. Also that they consider adjusting their subscription fee for the Nebraska History Magazine that is partially funded with general fund money. Then there is also authorization for them to accept as a gift any land within Block 63 which is where the building is located where they can accept as a gift any of that land that might be able to be utilized for parking space should such a gift be forthcoming. The one on the page 25 may be of some interest to some. It is the Nebraska Natural Resource Commission. One continues a limit on the maximum amount of projects that they would obligate for that would not exceed additional money that was appropriated this time, that is, no new project to be added in excess of the million eight that was authorized by this session. More significantly perhaps is the requirement that the match be not...no more than 50% match with the local entities. Sometimes they do 50%, sometimes it is 25%.
