that a fifty-fifty match would be more appropriate. Then there is language on the state water plan on page 25 through page 33 and this is an exact language as was included in last year's intent bill with the exception of changing dates or reports consistent with what the original plan called for and is also language for replacements on the Advisory Committee and the language would require the same procedure as the original appointees, that is recommendations come from the Exec Board, from members of the Legislature to the Exec Board and from the Exec Board to the commission to fill any vacancies should they occur. Then there is language affecting the Department of Administrative Services and in this case it reflects their budget requests for the next session. Again it is to maximize the utilization of nongeneral fund sources for the operation of the various computer programs and the way it is suggested to do it is that all costs that are involved in the upkeep of the building are included in what they prorate back to an agency and that way we can use federal funds for cash funds where they are available for part of this. The Division of Communications has about a hundred and some thousand general fund monies. The suggestion is to eliminate that next time and use all revolving funds again with the same purpose to maximize the use of all other fund sources for the communication system and the last part of the last section of the bill relates to the Department of Personnel and it calls for similar reports that we have asked for in the past. It would be an updating of those reports. I move the bill be advanced, Mr. President.
