SENATOR KAHLE: Okay, well I don't want to take up time. While he is looking, could I ask Senator Warner a question?

PRESIDENT: Yes. Senator Warner, will you respond to a question from Senator Kahle?

SENATOR KAHLE: On pages 6 and 7 of the green copy, is that \$8,000,000 in revenue sharing that is under dependent children and on the other side of the page child welfare and status offender, the same \$16,000,000 that we talked about the other day?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR KAHLE: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: This is just for information. The appropriation is in 998.

SENATOR KAHLE: Yes. The figure at the bottom of the page there on page 7, the Medicare special fund, \$24,000,000, is that pass through money or is that state money?

SENATOR WARNER: No, General Fund money is state money.

SENATOR KAHLE: We are putting that much into Medicaid then in the state?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR KAHLE: Thank you. I don't think most people know that. They think that is all federal money.
