It amounts to twenty-five cents an acre and allows up to eight thousand acres to be sprayed per individual but it will bring some accountability into the program and I think it is downright ridiculous that last year they can't provide a printout, the Department of Agriculture, nationally or statewide can't provide a printout of who got the money and how much. I think we've got no business putting a million dollars into a program and not finding out who gets how much of the money. Actually this enlarges the scope of the program when you limit it to eight thousand acres per rancher and it assures the money. It doesn't reduce the total funds going into it but it insures that it will be spread around the state and that more individuals can participate in it. I urge the body support the amendment so we have some accountability in the program. Thank you.
